

We Need Food!

How much food do over 1,400 cats and 700 dogs eat? A whole lot. That's how many animals pass through our program in one year. It seems like we need about eleveny bazillion pounds (That's a real number doncha know?).

Planned Pethood continues to reach out to grocery stores, manufacturers and retail stores hoping we can get them to donate food to the homeless dogs and cats. Some groceries never have food to donate to us (or at least that's what they tell us). One pet store pours bleach over all the food they have thrown in the dumpster and cuts the collars into tiny bits so rescues can use the products. It falls to our foster families to purchase supplies for the animals they are saving. It's a large financial strain. And as we move into peak puppy/kitten season it's only going to mean the need is greater.

We are asking our supporters to consider dropping off some pet food to us.
